CARIE fulfills its core mission to improve the well being, rights and autonomy of older persons through

advocacy, education, and action through a "case to cause" model of advocacy that serves to promote equal access to justice and addresses problems and issues on both the individual and the systemic levels.

One program, among many, is the Pennsylvania Senior Medicare Patrol (SMP), produces the SCAM WIRE alerts we have posted online.
