Custom Driving Maps Now Available

e use a computer mapping program to determine what route would be

best for a new client. Built into that

program is the option to create driving directions.

What's exciting about this is A.) making it easy for a volunteer to change

to drive a new route or sub on an unfamiliar route, B.) making it easy for a recent new resident to drive a route if they moved to Erie yesterday and C.) possibly shortening the time it takes to drive a route

if the volunteer follows the software's driving directions.

Karen Hein tested our software on Rt. 10 last week. It shaved four minutes off her usual time which may not seem significant. But, it's 3½ hours a year. Now what if every volunteer saved four minutes? Faster meal deliveries to our clients! And, you may find it saves you significantly more

time. Try it! Just call and tell us what address you want to deliver <u>last</u> and we'll do the rest. If you test it against your usual time, we'll report your results in an upcoming Food For Thought.
