Erie Gives Results

The Erie Community Foundation held its second annual Erie Gives fundraising campaign on August 14th. The results showed a large and encouraging capacity of giving on behalf of Erie residents. This year there were 4,071 donors giving

\$1,126,803. This is a 46% increase over last year. And, it doesn't count the matching grant from ECF and GE totaling \$101,000 to be distributed as a pro-rata percentage among all participating nonprofits.

MEMOW performance was similar. Donors gave 29.5% more than last year and the number of donors increased by 40%. After the matching grant of 8.65%, Erie Gives provided the opportunity for donors to give a total of \$1,436.84 to Metro-Erie Meals On Wheels. All donations will go to fill the funding gap created by a decrease in the Human Services Development Fund. The HSDF allows us to serve Under 60 Persons With Disabilities.
